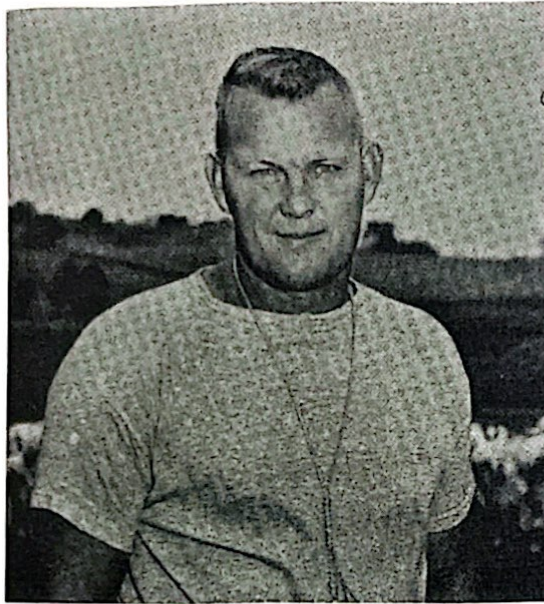


HONOREES



R.V. JOHNSON
VARSITY FOOTBALL AND GOLF COACH

THEY SIMPLY CALLED HIM "COACH".....a 27 year teaching and coaching career at College Park High. Coach Johnson was a football and track star at Garfield H.S. in East L.A. He was a four year starting tackle at St. Mary's College (1946-49) in Moraga where he earned All-Coast Conference and All-Catholic All-American Honors and was drafted in round #4 by the NFL New York Giants. He is a current member of St. Mary's College Hall of Fame. Coach Johnson was the first varsity head coach at College Park H.S. in 1960 and was at the helm of what local sports writers called the greatest football game ever played in the DVAL: the 1963 Mt. Diablo-College Park game that ended in a 26-26 tie. Coach led CP to its first DVAL Championship in Golf in 1962 and had individual league champions and numerous section champions as well as a number of golfers who went on to have stellar careers at colleges and universities throughout the country, some garnering PGA card holder status and playing on the minor PGA tours. He currently resides in Sonoma with his wife of 53 years Barbara.
