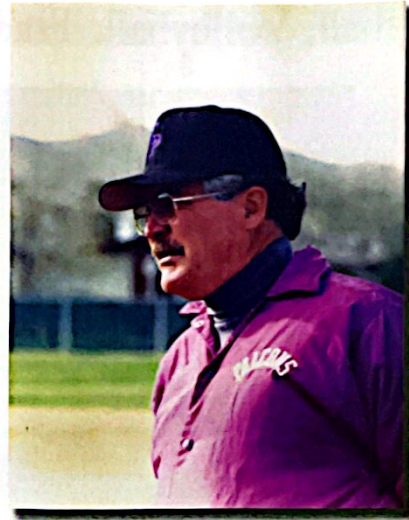


COACH GEORGE ROBINSON
